DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Superintendent at the Marie H. Katzenbach School for the Deaf, Department of Education, is responsible for overseeing the residential programs and activities of a residence or dormitory; does related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience in direct care training and supervision of the hearing impaired in a residential setting, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

SPECIAL SKILL:

Appointees must be able to communicate effectively in American Sign Language, at the intermediate or an equivalent level to perform the duties of this position.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute non-supervisory experience as noted above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: Applicants must pass the Sign Communication Proficiency Interview (SCPI) administered by the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Committee at the school at the intermediate or an equivalent level.
